



Parkview High School Viking Athletic Hall of Fame

Parkview High School celebrates its outstanding athletic tradition by naming former Parkview High School athletes, coaches, and friends of the athletic program to the Parkview High School Viking Athletic Hall of Fame. The Hall of Fame recognizes individuals for:

- The successes he or she achieved while being a student-athlete at PHS.
- The successes he or she achieved while serving as a coach at PHS.
- Distinguished service to PHS athletics.

Parkview High School Viking Athletic Hall of Fame Objectives:

- To give deserved recognition to outstanding PHS athletes, coaches and supportive individuals of athletics.
- To illustrate to current students and community members those individuals who have been instrumental in creating the outstanding Viking athletic tradition.
- To promote continued interest in the Viking athletic program via alumni and community members.
- To publicly celebrate Parkview High School's outstanding athletic tradition on a yearly basis through the annual induction process.

Athlete Nominee Criteria:

1. The nominee must have been a PHS athlete and a varsity letter winner.
2. The nominee must be a PHS graduate.
3. Individual accomplishments within a sport are essential (e.g. all-state selection, state championships, all-conference, state records, school records).
4. Contributions made to the success of a team are important (e.g. team state championship, team conference championship, team record).
5. Having individual and team success in multiple sports is valued.
6. While athletic achievement is the focal criteria, moral character and good citizenship during the athlete's time at Parkview High School will be taken into consideration.
7. The nominee must have graduated no less than 10 years from the induction date.

Coaching Nominee Criteria:

1. The nominee must have been a coach at Parkview High School. Coaching over a long period of time and in multiple sports at the 9th grade, JV, and varsity levels are valued.
2. Excellence in coaching is essential (e.g. record, conference championships, state competitions, team state championships, individuals coached who earned state championships, etc.).
3. Contributions to the positive development of students are important.

4. Contributions to PHS, the Parkview community, the conference, the coach's state association, and the WIAA are respected.
5. The nominee must have retired as a coach a minimum of three years before the induction date.

Distinguished Service Nominee Criteria:

1. Any individual who made significant contributions to Parkview athletics in roles other than participation in or coaching a sport (e.g. former employees of the Parkview School District, alumni, community members).
2. Longevity of contributions over time is essential (contributions of time, energy, and money will receive consideration).
3. Modeling of sportsmanship and dedication, while inspiring similar traits in others is valued.
4. Demonstrating a special care and concern for the development of student-athletes is important (e.g. inspiring students intellectually, physically, socially, or spiritually).
5. If given to a school district employee, the person cannot be currently employed by the Parkview School District.
6. If given to a non-school district employee, the person may still be a current contributor to Parkview Athletics.

Nomination Process:

Nominations must be submitted on the Hall of fame Nomination Form. Viking Athletic Hall of Fame Forms are available in the Parkview High School Athletic office or on the Parkview High School Athletics website. Nominations are due by June 1st of each year.

Nominations may be submitted by:

- PHS alumni
- Parkview school district residents
- Current and former PHS coaches of any level
- Current and former Parkview School District employees
- Current members of the Viking Athletic Hall of Fame

Selection Process:

The Hall of fame Selection Committee reviews the list of nominations. Members research each nominee's qualifications and presents findings to the committee. Discussion follows and if needed, further research follows. Election is done by secret ballot.

Athlete Nominees: No more than five athletes are elected in one year with the exception of the first year. Those who are inducted are the five with the most votes and who have received votes from half or more of the Selection Committee members present at the selection meeting. Those individuals not receiving enough votes for induction will have their nomination automatically rolled over indefinitely.

Coaching Nominees: No more than two coaches are elected in one year with the exception of the first year. Those who are inducted are the two with the most votes and who have received votes from half or more of the Selection Committee members present at the selection meeting. Those individuals not receiving enough votes for induction will have their nomination automatically rolled over indefinitely. There need not be a coach inductee in any given year.

Distinguished Service Athletic Award: No more than one Distinguished Service Athletic Award is elected in one year with the exception of the first year. The recipient inducted are the nominee with the most votes and who have received votes from half or more of the Selection Committee members present at the selection meeting. Those nominees not receiving enough votes for induction will have their nomination automatically rolled over indefinitely. There need not be a Distinguished Service Athletic Award inductee in any given year.

Cost Maintenance: The Parkview School District shall be the sole owner of the Viking Athletic Hall of fame. The Parkview School District will maintain the Hall of Fame in a manner consistent with the honor of the recognition. The Parkview Athletic Booster Club will be asked, on an annual basis, to assist in the funding of the recognition plaques.
