

OPPORTUNITIES FOR DEVELOPMENT

The Board believes that inservice training for its members is vital in order for the Board to govern the District in the most informed and prudent manner possible. Informed decision making grows more important as school governance becomes increasingly complex.

In keeping with this position, the Board encourages the participation of its members at appropriate school board conferences, conventions, seminars and workshops. The Board shall pay any attendance fee and shall reimburse Board members for travel outside the District and other necessary expenses in accordance with District practice.

The district administrator shall report regularly on upcoming inservice opportunities for Board members. The Board shall select representatives to these sessions from among the membership. The members selected shall report to the Board on the inservice session attended and shall share information, materials and recommendations acquired by attending the session.
