

STUDENT WORK-STUDY PROGRAM

High school students may participate in a work-study program in accordance with established guidelines.

The work-study program shall be designed to give students an opportunity to receive on-the-job training in occupations that they plan to pursue after high school. The on-the-job training shall be a part of the student's daily school schedule.

The employer and the school will jointly plan an educational work program based upon the student's occupational interests, abilities and needs. Students shall be closely supervised and their progress evaluated by both the school and the employer.
