## INSTRUCTIONAL ARRANGEMENTS

The Board directs the district administrator and the instructional staff to make such arrangements for use of facilities, materials, personnel, time and other resources, that shall provide the most favorable learning environment for students.

The Board requests recommendations about ways to improve instructional arrangements, including, but not limited to, the following:

- 1. Providing for adequate classroom and other instructional space;
- 2. Setting class size ranges and limits;
- 3. Providing funds and facilities for necessary and desired learning activities; and
- 4. Showing adaptability in permitting innovations reflecting current trends, research and experimentation.
