

INDEPENDENT STUDY PROGRAM

An independent study program shall be available to junior and senior level* students in the Parkview School District. The Independent Study process (request, approved paperwork and course entry into student schedules) must be completed within the first two weeks of each semester. The program shall be designed to allow students to pursue other courses of study above and beyond what is normally provided for during the school day.

Independent study projects shall be monitored and advised by a certified teacher as determined by the building principal. Independent study classes will be approved at the discretion of the high school principal and the school counselor.

Costs associated with independent study are to be determined and indicated by the independent study teacher and will be the responsibility of the student.
