ACADEMIC RECOGNITION

Honor rolls shall be published in the District each nine weeks. Students in grades 9 through 12 earning the following grade point averages shall be eligible for District honor rolls:

Highest Honors 4.00High Honors 3.5 - 3.999Honorable Mention 3.00 - 3.499

Students achieving a cumulative 3.8 GPA or higher over the first three grading periods each year receive an academic patch and pin. Students achieving a cumulative 3.5 GPA or higher during the first seven semesters will receive an honor cord for graduation. The valedictorian and salutatorian will be recognized in accordance with District procedures.

(Grade Point Averages will be rounded up to two decimal points and will be capped at 4.00.)

The following point values-will be used for all students in grades 9-12:

The Grade Point Average (GPA) for all students 9-12 is calculated by the number of credits taken per semester and the grades received for these courses. The final GPA is affected by the number of courses you have taken (example: two students have the exact same grades but because one student has taken more courses his/her grade point will be higher).
