GUIDELINES FOR EARLY GRADUATION

- 1. Conference must be held with the high school counselor to determine if all credit requirements have been met.
- 2. Meet the requirements on the early graduation agreement signed by student, parent, school counselor and principal. If requirements are not met, prior to school starting in September of graduating year, then the student will not graduate early and will be required to attend full year.
- 3. Conference must be held with the high school counselor, principal, parents or guardian, and student in regard to the advisability of early graduation. Conference must be completed one semester prior to graduation.
- 4. The student will be invited and encouraged to take part in the graduation exercises at the end of the school year.
- 5. The student must request and apply to the high school counselor no later than one (1) semester prior to their desired early graduation date.
- 6. Must have all financial obligations paid in full by the end of the quarter *prior to* the graduating semester. Example: If a student is graduating in January, all fees must be paid by the end of quarter three. If this stipulation is not met, the student will not be allowed to graduate early and must attend the full year.
