SUMMER SCHOOL

The purpose of summer school shall be for remedial help, for students to make up of courses and to allow a student to accelerate in the curriculum. Courses offered in the summer school shall be based on needs of students.

All children residing within the District boundaries during the previous academic school year shall be considered resident students of the District for summer school purposes. Summer school tuition and fees shall be charged for specific summer school programs to the extent authorized by state law. Such fee shall be payable upon registration. Students enrolled in summer school shall be expected to attend on a daily basis. Student absences shall be approved in line with the District's established attendance procedures.

Students shall be expected to provide their own transportation to and from summer school classes except for certain special education classes and special programs as determined by the District.

The Fourth of July will be observed and no classes will be held that day.

A student will earn course credit for successful completion of course requirements as determined by the summer school instructor and high school principal.
