STUDENT FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES

The only fundraising drives that will be officially recognized and permitted must have the express approval of the Board.

Students shall not be required to campaign to raise funds for any purpose. With Board approval, students may participate in fundraising at school that is connected to a District program, school or activity.

The organization or program must obtain written permission from the parent/guardian for any student age 12 or under that is asked to solicit and/or sell merchandise or seek donations. Students under age 9 may only solicit and/or sell merchandise or seek donations for a fundraiser if they are accompanied by a parent/guardian or a person 16 years of age or older.

Guidelines shall be established for conducting fundraising activities in accordance with state law.
