

FULL-TIME STUDENTS

The Parkview Board of Education hereby defines full-time students as follows:

Elementary

Students must be scheduled for the full school day and four year old kindergarten students for one-half day.

Junior High

Students must take a minimum of six (6) classes each semester.

High School

High school students must be enrolled in classes or participating in Board-approved activities during each class period of each school day throughout their high school years. A student must be enrolled in a minimum of six credits per year to be considered a full-time student.

Students With Disabilities

Students with disabilities may be enrolled in less than a minimum program if required by the Individual Education Plan (IEP) or 504 plan.

Students Participating in any Board Authorized Programs

Students enrolled in alternative educational programs, or who participate in other program or receive curriculum modifications approved by school officials are considered full-time students.

Open Enrolled & Tuition Waiver Students

Resident students attending public school in another school district under the full-time public school open enrollment law or a tuition waiver in accordance with state law are also considered a full-time student under this policy. Students attending another district through open enrollment, tuition-waiver or voucher are considered full-time for budgetary purposes only and not for extra-curricular or athletic purposes.
