

**PARTICIPATION OF NON-PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS
IN DISTRICT COURSES/PROGRAMS**

Students living in the district, but enrolled in a private school, parochial school or home-based private educational program who have met the standards for admission to a course may apply for enrollment for a maximum of two (2) courses. Enrollment is contingent on the school board determining that there is sufficient space in the classroom.

Instructional materials and equipment shall not be available to non-public school students. The director of student services or building principals may provide parents with general information about grade level academic expectations. This should in no way, however, be construed to include providing lesson plans or the use of instructional materials.

Homeschool students may participate in sports and extracurricular activities on the same basis and to the same extent as students enrolled full-time at Parkview. A parent/guardian must provide a statement confirming that the student meets the board's requirements outlined in the co-curricular code of conduct. Participation fees will be the same as for full-time Parkview students.
