CARE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY BY STUDENTS

Students should share in the responsibility of keeping the District schools in their best possible condition.

Students who vandalize or negligently damage school property shall be subject to school disciplinary action and may be referred to law enforcement for criminal prosecution. Students involved in vandalism, and their parents/guardians, shall be held financially responsible for damages to the extent authorized by law.

The Board strongly opposes vandalism against school property. The causes of such misbehavior often are complex, calling for careful study by parents, school staff and appropriate community officials to determine the causes. The district administrator, or his/her designee, shall be directed to establish rules for dealing with this behavior.
