DISTRICT NEWSLETTER OR ONLINE PUBLICATION

The District has defined the following policy guidelines regarding the publication and distribution of the District newsletter.

- A. The purpose of the District Newsletter or Online Publication is to
 - 1. Provide information about the District to those who attend school in the District, work in the District or live in the District.
 - 2. Act as a vehicle for the sharing of student/staff accolades and accomplishments.
 - 3. Provide a permanent record of the history of the school.
 - 4. Present community information as it relates to District activities.
- B. Material to be published
 - 1. Items published in the District newsletter or online publication will follow the ethics of responsible journalism and excellence in writing.
 - 2. Information may not include statements, labels, jokes, or any other material that is demeaning or that could be construed in a negative way.
 - 3. Information may not conflict with the District's educational mission and philosophy or infringe upon the rights of other students or staff in the educational environment.
 - 4. Language, pictures, music and symbols will not be permitted if they are obscene, libelous, infringe upon other student or staff rights, or are otherwise offensive to good taste.
 - 5. The administrator must approve the printing of material previously published in a professional publication even if permission is given by the author and publication.
 - 6. The District newsletter or online publication may not endorse candidates.
 - 7. Expressions of opinion should be responsible, balanced, and well-researched.
 - 8. All materials to be printed are subject to review by the editor for compliance with the provisions of this policy.
 - 9. The editor will consult with the district administrator with any questions about the suitability of material for publication.
 - 10. The District newsletter or online publication is not a public forum.
