NAMING SCHOOL DISTRICT FACILITIES

Naming facilities, i.e., buildings, wings, rooms, playgrounds, is a matter of great importance deserving thoughtful attention. Naming of District facilities will be by majority vote of the School Board. A written nomination containing the rationale for the nomination must be presented to the Board for action.

Prior to action by the Board, the nomination will be referred to a committee, which includes the Board President, District Administrator, a principal, a professional staff member, a support staff member, and a citizen to be named by the Board President. The committee will make a recommendation on the nomination to the Board.

Criteria which must be met before referring a nomination to the Board include:

- 1. A facility may be named after a geographic location and/or a section of the District it serves.
- 2. Facilities may also be named after major financial contributors to the District; without whom new facilities would not have been possible.
- 3. If a facility is to be named after a person, that person must have displayed outstanding character and leadership. If the person was a District employee or student, the person's school record must not contain significant disciplinary issues such as suspension or expulsion for a student or suspension or termination for an employee.
- 4. If a facility is to be named after a person, that person must have displayed outstanding contributions to education in the Parkview School District, for humanity, or the Parkview community, and have consistently demonstrated high personal integrity as well as conduct that reflects the values the District seeks to instill in its students.
- 5. If the nominee is an employee or a Board member, a nomination will be considered by the Board no less than four years following the retirement of the employee or Board member.
- 6. In the case of the death of a Board member, an employee, former employee or student, the Board will consider a nomination no less than four years after the date of death.

Portions of outdoor facilities may be named after individuals using the same criteria or recognition of individuals as described above and may be marked on an appropriate sign or plaque commemorating that individual's contribution.
