Message about Food Service Billing

The District recently experienced an issue with its point of sale system that unfortunately affected a number of families within the District. Upon learning of this issue, I requested data on all families affected so that School Messenger lunch calls could be shut down for families impacted by the error. My hope was that this would allow me to be the first contact regarding this issue, but it appears that I missed shutting down the calls to at least one family. If you did receive a call due to this error I sincerely apologize.

I want to reassure all Parkview families that once I learned of this error, food service staff were advised to feed all children, regardless of their balance, and to further not discuss lunch account balances with any students until the cause of the error could be determined. I also want to reassure all families that our District policies do not allow any student at the elementary to be denied a lunch and also allows students at the Junior High/High School to receive lunch until parents can be contacted regarding negative balances.

I will be reviewing all families impacted by this error again tomorrow and personally contacting any families affected. All students of families affected will continue to be fed while we diagnose the cause of this error and resolve it.

1. GO TO THE PARKVIEW RSCHOOL ATHLETICS SCHEDULE WEBSITE (type link below or click link on Parkview Athletics page):

2. CHOOSE ADVANCED VIEW REPORT ON YOUR RSCHOOL HOME PAGE

3. CHOOSE YOUR FILTERS AND THEN GENERATE REPORT.

A suggestion is that you choose ALL for activity and gender. You can do this process twice. Once for HOME events and then again for AWAY events. That way you can distinguish the events on your calendar by color.

4. CHOOSE THE CALENDAR ICON ON THE TOP RIGHT CORNER.

5. CHOOSE THE CALENDAR TYPE YOU USE.

6. THAT SHOULD BE IT. WAIT A BIT FOR IT TO SYNC.

NOW AT YOUR GOOGLE CALENDAR (OR OUTLOOK)

YOU HAVE THE ABILITY TO MAKE SOME DECISIONS.
