Fire Prevention Week

The Orfordville Fire Department visited PES on Tuesday and talked the students about fire safety and showed them an ambulance and a fire truck. They also demonstrated what a fire fighter looks like in full gear including an air mask to make sure the students knew not to be afraid of a fire fighters if they should be caught in a fire. They also review Stop, Drop and Roll and had the kindergarteners practice covering their faces and rolling to make sure they understood how to do it in the event their clothing should catch fire. Additionally they talked to the students about having a family meeting place away from the home in case of a home fire and suggested each family should have not only a meeting place, but a plan for exiting the house in case of a fire. Having family drills (just like they have at school) is strongly encouraged.
