## NOTICE OF CHILD FIND ACTIVITY

The school district must locate, identify and evaluate all resident children with disabilities, including children with disabilities attending private schools, regardless of the severity of their disabilities. The school district has a special education screening program to locate and screen all children with suspected disabilities; who are residents of the district and who have not graduated from high school, to determine whether a special education referral is appropriate. Annually the district conducts developmental screening of preschool children. Each child's motor, communication and social skills are observed at various play areas. Each child is weighed and measured and the child's hearing vision is checked. The information is used to provide parents with a profile of their child's current development and to provide suggestions for follow up activities.

A physician, nurse, psychologist, social worker or administrator of a social agency who reasonable believes a child brought to him or her for services is a child with a disability, has a legal duty to report the child to the school district in which the child resides. Before referring the child, the person making the referral must inform the child's parent that the referral will be made. The referral must be in writing and include the reason why the person believes the child is a child with a disability. Others who reasonably believe a child is a child with a disability may also refer the child to the school district in which the child resides.
