

APPROVAL OF HANDBOOKS

Student and employee handbooks shall be developed to serve as the basis for enforcement of school rules and these handbooks shall be reviewed annually and updated accordingly. Handbooks shall be used to ensure that all parents, students and staff are cognizant of the rules used to govern the schools.

The principals shall develop student handbooks consistent with Board policies and state and federal laws and regulations. The district administrator shall develop a District employee handbook outlining the key regulations and rules. The District employee handbook will be reviewed/revised annually by the Policy Committee and approved by the Board of Education prior to the start of the new school year.

Copies of student and employee handbooks shall be distributed at the beginning of each school year or upon entry to the district if attendance begins after the start of the school year.
