COMPUTER AND TECHNOLOGY INSTRUCTION

The Board recognizes that computers and other technologies have become increasingly important in today's rapidly changing technological world. Therefore, the Parkview School District shall provide students with educational opportunities and programs that provide quality technology literacy experiences in computers and other technologies.

Computer and other technology literacy curricula shall be developed and taught by subject area teachers in cooperation with the library media specialists, the director of instruction and technology, and the administration. The goal shall be to improve the achievement of all students through the integration of technology into the curriculum in all subject areas.

The director of instruction and technology and the district library media specialist shall meet regularly to discuss the effectiveness of the district's computer and other technology literacy programs. The effectiveness of these programs shall be reported as an integral component of the state-mandated and Board approved Parkview Information (Library Media) and Technology Plan.
