

CLASS SIZE

The Parkview School District Board of Education believes that many factors must be given consideration in the establishment of class size. Every effort will be made to maintain classes at a sound educational level. However, this provision should in no way interfere with the ability of the Board and administration to experiment with different forms of classroom instruction.

At the junior high and high school level (grades levels 6-12), the administration will determine class enrollments and staffing arrangements, based on student registration and scheduling during the second semester of each school year.

At the elementary level (grade levels 4K-5), recommendations on staffing and assignment of students to schools will be based on enrollment projections made during the second semester of each school year.

The following guidelines will be used to help determine the number of sections at each grade level:

4 Year-Old Kindergarten	16-22 students
Kindergarten	16-22 students
First Grade	20-24 students
Second Grade	20-24 students
Third Grade	22-26 students
Fourth Grade	22-26 students
Fifth Grade	22-26 students
Sixth Grade	22-26 students
Seventh Grade	22-26 students
Eighth Grade	22-26 students
Ninth Grade	23-27 students
Tenth Grade	23-27 students
Eleventh Grade	23-27 students
Twelfth Grade	23-27 students

Class sizes will vary due to curriculum and space needs. However, every effort will be made to limit the maximum class size to 30. No high school regular education class will be permitted to operate with fewer than seven (7) students. The Superintendent has the authority to waive these minimum and maximum numbers when necessary and appropriate.
