STUDENT AID PROGRAMS

Parents/caregivers who claim that the financial conditions of their families are such that they cannot afford to pay for required materials, supplies, fees and other charges may request a waiver of student and co-curricular fees from the District.

Before any student or co-curricular fees are waived, the parent/caregiver of the student(s) shall submit a statement of need to the building principal or district administrator for evaluation. A current and completed application for free/reduced lunch must be on file in the business office before consideration for a waiver of any student or co-curricular fees. If the student's family is on welfare, or is receiving aid from any of the welfare organizations, this fact should be noted on the statement. The parent/caregiver of the student(s), and the school in which the student(s) will be attending, shall be advised of any action taken by the building principal or district administrator.
