STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

Students shall be informed by the counseling office of any available scholarships. The school counselor publicizes available scholarships on the scholarship page of the District website.

Students attending the Parkview School District full time under Wisconsin's Open Enrollment Law shall be eligible for scholarships on the same basis as resident students.

The District shall not unlawfully discriminate in the acceptance or administration of gifts, bequests, scholarships and other aids, benefits or services to students – including those from private agencies, organizations or persons - on the basis of sex, race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability, handicap or zip code. Discrimination complaints shall be process in accordance with established procedures.

Procedure

- 1. The school counseling office disseminates information about scholarships through appropriate means, which may include announcements, school email and the District websites.
- 2. Local Scholarships Several local and regional organizations and individuals have established scholarships for Parkview seniors. The scholarship providers establish all scholarship criteria. Each December, the scholarship packet containing all scholarship information is provided to all seniors in their classrooms. The Parkview Site Team will review all applications and select the recipients. Applications submitted after the indicated deadline will not be considered.
- 4. Wisconsin Academic Excellence Scholarship This is a scholarship offered by the Higher Education Aids Board (HEAB) of Wisconsin. It is awarded to the senior or seniors with the highest GPA. The intent of the HEAB is to encourage the students to stay in Wisconsin for their postsecondary education. The number of scholarships awarded to each high school is based on total student enrollment in grades 9-12. The criteria used to select the District's Wisconsin Academic Excellence Scholarship designee(s) is/are outlined in Policy #461 Wisconsin Higher Academic Excellence Higher Education Scholarship.
