

SAFETY PROGRAM

Every reasonable precaution shall be taken for the safety of students, employees, visitors and others having business with the Parkview School District. The Board shall demand compliance with all regulations, state codes and orders of the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations, the Department of Safety and Professional Services and all applicable local safety and health codes and regulations.

The district administrator, or designee, shall be responsible for coordinating all activities related to the safety, security, and health considerations of the buildings, grounds, and equipment of the entire district. The district administrator, or designee, shall appoint a School Safety Advisory Committee consisting of district administrators, pupil services professionals, and law enforcement to offer direction and support in the planning and implementation of an effective safety program and emergency preparedness plan for the school district. The School Safety Advisory Committee shall meet periodically, but not less than once every three years, to review and/or modify the existing emergency preparedness plan to be presented to, and adopted by, the Board of Education. This review will include the following safety areas:

- a. Fire
- b. Tornado, bomb, or disaster evacuation
- c. Building maintenance
- d. Playground supervision
- e. Physical education and athletics
- f. Laboratory instruction
- g. Shop instruction
- h. Student safety patrol
- i. School bus safety
- j. Health and first aid

Building principals shall ensure all faculty, staff, and students are trained on safety protocols and coordinate at least two safety drills each school year. Buildings, grounds and equipment shall be inspected at least annually for potential or demonstrated safety and health hazards. Hazardous conditions shall be corrected, compensating devices installed, or special arrangements made to provide for safe and healthful facilities. By January 1 of each year, the district administrator, or designee, shall be responsible for filing a copy of the school district emergency preparedness plan with the Wisconsin Office of School Safety.
