

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

The Board shall provide transportation services to all school children living two or more miles from their school of attendance and to school children living in "areas of unusual hazard" (see Policy #751.4). In addition, the Board shall provide transportation for children with exceptional educational needs in accordance with state law and shall provide transportation for out-of-district extracurricular activities.

Transportation services shall be under the direction of the District Administrator or his/her designee. The Board considers school buses to be an extension of the school facility.

Therefore, all rules and regulations concerning student conduct shall be enforced. Administrators have the authority to revoke transportation services for students who fail to observe such rules and regulations.

Daycare centers within two miles of the District may request transportation to and from school if they meet all of the requirements listed below:

1. The daycare center must be state-licensed and provide a copy of their license annually to the District.
2. In order for transportation to be provided to the daycare center, they must have initial approval from the Board.
3. The availability of transportation to and from daycare centers that are located within the two-mile distance from the school will be limited to either a parent/guardian's first or second pick up or drop off transportation request
