

PUBLIC INFORMATION PROGRAM

The Board recognizes the importance of having the informed support of the public. Therefore, public and school media shall be used to channel information about the District and school activities into homes throughout the District. Specifically, the Board shall:

1. Make notices of Board and District meetings, the agendas for such meetings, and reports of the business transacted at such meetings available to the residents by posting the information on the District's website.
2. Make information concerning the educational activities, students and personnel of the District available to the residents by means of our social media platforms.
3. Encourage personnel to contact parents frequently concerning the educational needs and accomplishments of their children.
4. Keep parents informed of school activities and calendar of events through the publication of a school newsletter and through other media sources such as the District webpage, automated phone messaging and social media.
