

TOBACCO/SNUFF/E-CIGARETTE USE ON SCHOOL PREMISES

The Board is dedicated to providing a healthy, comfortable and productive environment for students, staff, spectators and visitors. It is the intention of the District to maintain tobacco-free, E-cigarette, vaping and snuff free schools.

- The Board believes that education has a central role in establishing patterns of behavior related to good health and supports classroom-based instruction on tobacco use prevention, including training for teachers whose instructional duties include tobacco, snuff, vaping and E-cigarette use prevention content. Tobacco includes cigarettes, cigars, pipe tobacco and smokeless tobacco (i.e. chewing tobacco).
- Tobacco, snuff, vaping or E-cigarette use by students, staff and all other individuals is prohibited at all times in all school buildings, on all school premises and at all school-sponsored functions.
- Tobacco, snuff, vaping or E-cigarette advertising and promotional products are prohibited on school premises, in school publications, and at all school-sponsored functions. In addition, no student or staff shall be permitted to wear any clothing that depicts, promotes or advertises tobacco, snuff, vaping or E-cigarette products while on school premises and at school-sponsored functions.

School employees, students and members of the public shall be notified of this policy through such means as student and staff handbooks, school newsletters and posted notices at all school entrances and other prominent locations on school premises.

Violation of the tobacco, snuff, vaping or E-cigarette prohibitions by students and staff will result in school disciplinary actions. In addition, information about tobacco, snuff, vaping or E-cigarette cessation and related services will be provided to students and staff who violate the policy.

Members of the public who violate the tobacco, snuff, vaping or E-cigarette use prohibition will be asked to discontinue use of the tobacco, snuff, vaping or E-cigarette product or leave the premises. Law enforcement officials may be contacted as necessary and appropriate.
