Blog – Superintendent Search Survey

It is hard to believe that the first month of the school year has already passed – time certainly does move swiftly. At the beginning of September, I sent a survey to the staff asking them what qualities they would like the School Board to look for in their next superintendent. I was pleased that over eighty (80) staff members responded. Last week, I emailed the Superintendent Search Survey to students and guardians asking them the same questions and so far over one hundred (100) individuals have responded. This week, I am asking for your help. I would like to have as many individuals respond to the survey as possible, so I am asking you to take the survey, if you have not already done so and also to **share** this survey with as many individuals as you can. It is like throwing a pebble in a lake, once the pebble hits the water it starts to send out waves that reach a great distance. It is my hope that as you take and share this survey that more and more people will have the opportunity to share their thoughts and opinions with the Board.

The survey should only take about five to ten minutes to complete. The survey is completely anonymous and the results will be reviewed by the Board and used to help guide the hiring process. Here are the survey questions:
