

SCHOOL DISTRICT LEGAL STATUS

The public school district is an agency of the State, and as such, must operate within the confine of state laws and regulations.

The official name of this school district is the "Parkview School District". It is classified as a common school district, and includes all of the villages of Orfordville and Footville, all of the towns of Newark and Plymouth, and portions of the towns of Avon, Center, Magnolia, Rock, and Spring Valley in Rock County.

Educational services of the school district shall be organized as a program of instruction for grades Early Childhood through 12. The district shall be operated as a single system by the Board under the day-to-day management of the district administrator.

The Parkview School District shall consist of at least one elementary school and a junior/senior high school. The Board may authorize the district administrator to establish other special classrooms or programs when necessary.
