BOARD ELECTIONS

The Board shall be elected at the general election held on the first Tuesday in April of each year, following the procedure outlined for such election by the state statutes.

If there are more than twice as many candidates as there are members to be elected to the Board, the Board shall require a primary election for such positions. The primary election shall be held at the time specified by law for the spring primary.

The Board Clerk shall notify the clerks of each municipality if a primary is to be held, and shall also notify them of the spring election. The clerks shall be furnished with a copy of the Board election notice and with an adequate supply of ballots for the elections.

Two members of the seven (7) member Board shall be elected at large each year, with the exception of every three (3) years when three (3) board members will be elected. Board member terms of office will be for three (3) years, except as otherwise specifically provided by law. Elected Board members' term of office shall commence on the fourth Monday in April. Board members elected shall, before taking office, take and sign an oath of office administered by the Board Clerk.
