

## GOAL SETTING

The Parkview School District is a strong advocate of the goal setting process. The Board recognizes the value of the process for school improvement. The goal setting process involves assessing district-wide needs and concerns and translating such concerns into achievable goals. The goal setting process provides direction for administrative and school board action.

The goal setting process will be accomplished annually by the Board. Upon completion, the administrative team will develop an action plan and timetable to facilitate successful completion of the goals. Goals will be monitored and adjusted if necessary throughout the year. Longer range goals in the range of five to ten years may also be determined.

Goal setting processes will also be used by the administration as a way to set annual school improvements progress.

Goals of both the Board and administration will be shared with the public, and will hopefully be the impetus for continued school improvement.
