

NEW BOARD MEMBER ORIENTATION

Under the guidance of experienced board members and the District Administrator, orientation will be provided to new board members through activities such as these:

- (1) Workshop for new board members conducted by state and area school board associations.
- (2) Discussion and visits with other board members, the District Administrator, and other members of the school staff.
- (3) Provision of materials on school board policies and administrative procedures.
- (4) Guided tour of district facilities.
- (5) Issuance of necessary materials such as Ipad, District ID and Key fob.

Orientation shall be considered as an ongoing process for all board members and may include such activities as those indicated above and the addition of items such as these:

- (1) Attendance at school board and administrative conferences and conventions.
- (2) Exchange of ideas through joint meetings with neighboring school boards.
