

TEMPORARY ADMINISTRATIVE ASSIGNMENTS

In any organization, it is important that the responsibility for decision-making be clearly established in the event of absence of the designated administrator.

When the district administrator is unavailable, the high school principal shall serve as acting administrator. Any decisions that need to be made before the district administrator becomes available will be the responsibility of the high school principal.

If the district administrator and high school principal are unavailable, the business manager shall be assigned to serve as acting administrator.
