

4K INSTRUCTION

The Parkview School District shall operate a voluntary half day 4K kindergarten program in which all children of the district who are four years old prior to September 1 of the current school year may enroll. There will be no early admittance to 4K.

The parent(s)/guardian(s) of a child enrolling in 4K shall submit the child's birth certificate, immunization records and a medical certificate stating the child is in good physical health.

The parent(s)/guardian(s) are encouraged to enroll their child in the full week, half-day 4K program. While not encouraged, a parent/guardian may enroll their 4K student in a modified program with the understanding that their child will attend the all-day five year old kindergarten program the following year.

Physical facilities, equipment and materials shall be provided for a program which will provide instruction that will promote growth in social-emotional development, language development, literacy and cognitive development, physical development, and aesthetic development and motivation.

The 4K program shall be aligned to standards approved by the state of Wisconsin. All 4K teachers shall be certified by the Department of Public Instruction to teach at the appropriately assigned grade level.
