

KINDERGARTEN INSTRUCTION

The Parkview School District shall operate a full day 5K kindergarten program in which all children of the district who are five years old on or before September 1 of the current school year may enroll.

Physical facilities, equipment and materials shall be provided for a program which will provide instruction that will promote growth in social-emotional development, language development, literacy and cognitive development, physical development, and aesthetic development and motivation.

The Kindergarten program shall be aligned to standards approved by the State of Wisconsin and provide instruction for all students to learn basic concepts and skills in reading, language, social studies, mathematics, science, fine arts, health, and physical education. In addition, the development of social skills shall be an integral component of the Kindergarten program.

All Kindergarten teachers shall be certified by the Department of Public Instruction to teach at the appropriately assigned grade level.
