

ADULT EDUCATION

The Board recognizes the need in the service area for an adult education program to meet the needs of all citizens who desire it. Therefore, adult residents shall have the opportunity to participate in educational programs in the district.

Adult residents may be permitted to attend classes at Parkview High School during the school day, tuition free, upon application to the high school principal. Residents may register for a full schedule of classes or only one or two classes. Adult residents, or high school graduates, desiring to enroll in high school classes may do so provided staff and facilities are available.

Criminal background check is required prior to enrollment. Criminal history will only be used to determine enrollment to the extent that the behavior would endanger students or staff.
