

## STUDENT PROGRESS REPORTS TO PARENTS

The Board believes that parents/guardians should be made aware of student progress in the instructional program.

Regular quarterly report cards shall be issued for each student in the district. In addition to report cards, parents/guardians can use Skyward Family Access to regularly monitor student progress.

Parent conferences may also be held during the school year to:

1. Supplement the report card and to serve as another means of reporting to parents.
2. Promote good relations between the home and the school.
3. Share information about student's success, accomplishments, and teacher concerns.
