

GUIDELINES FOR EARLY GRADUATION

1. Conference must be held with the high school guidance counselor to determine if all credit requirements have been met.
2. Meet the requirements on the early graduation agreement signed by student, parent, guidance counselor and principal. If requirements are not met, prior to school starting in September of graduating year, then student will not graduate early and will be required to attend full year.
3. Conference must be held with the high school guidance counselor, principal, parents or guardian, and student in regard to the advisability of early graduation. Conference must be completed one semester prior to graduation.
4. The student will be invited and encouraged to take part in the graduation exercises at the end of the school year.
5. The student must apply to the high school guidance counselor no later than one (1) semester prior to their desired early graduation date.
