GRADUATION CEREMONY

A student must have successfully completed all required credits for graduation, and official grades must be received for courses taken outside Parkview High School, in order to participate in the graduation ceremony.

Students with disabilities will be eligible to participate in the graduation ceremony when they have satisfied applicable program requirements as determined by their individualized education program (IEP) team.

These students will receive their diplomas at the end of the school year when they reach the age of 21, or sooner if their IEP goals and graduation requirements are met.

A student will only participate in the graduation ceremony one time.

Foreign exchange program students will be eligible to participate in the graduation ceremony but will not receive a Parkview High School Diploma. They will be given a certificate of attendance and a transcript of course work completed at Parkview High School.

The school administration reserves the right to deny participation in the graduation ceremony for disciplinary reasons and or unpaid financial obligations. All fees must be paid prior to graduation ceremony.

Any baccalaureate ceremony conducted is not endorsed by the District.
