CRITERIA FOR GRANTING HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS FOR ADULT DIPLOMAS

The following factors may be considered in assessing education and experience for granting high school credit towards a diploma for an adult that has exceeded the statutory age for attending school without graduating:

- 1. Credits previously earned and documented while attending high school.
- 2. Credits earned through extension and correspondence study.
- 3. Credits awarded on the basis of prior work training or experience.
- 4. Credits awarded on the basis of course work taken through the vocational, technical and adult education system. Credit awarded (limit 1 per subject tested) for completion of General Educational Development Option 2 (GEDO#2) training and successful completion of the test.
- 5. Credits awarded on the basis of approved apprenticeship training.
- 6. Credits awarded on the basis of examination.
- 7. Credits awarded on the successful job corps training or other approved program.
- 8. Credits awarded for military educational programs.
- 9. Credits awarded for secondary school work taken through a college or university.
- 10. Credits awarded for independent study programs.
- 11. Credits earned in foreign countries.
- 12. Credits awarded for summer school study.
- 13. Credits awarded on the basis of approved virtual learning opportunities, including online course work.
- 14. Credits awarded for any other successful educational experience.
