SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

Students seeking admission in the District shall meet the state entrance age requirements and shall reside within established District boundaries, except as otherwise provided by law and/or Board policy.

Students transferring from other school systems are required to provide a transcript of academic accomplishments at the previous school, or the address from which this data may be secured. Students entering the District from a home-based private educational program or private school shall be required to provide any available academic information and may be required to take appropriate academic tests to assist in making a placement. The District reserves the right to determine grade placement of students transferring into the District.

Students admitted to the District shall present immunization records as required by law. Students entering kindergarten in the District shall also be requested to provide evidence that their eyes have been examined by an optometrist or evaluated by a physician.

The District shall not discriminate in admissions to any school, class, program or activity or facility usage on the basis of any characteristic protected under State or Federal law including, but not limited to race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital status, parental status, sexual orientation, sex (including transgender status, change of sex or gender identity) physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability ("protected classes") or homelessness. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.

Nothing in this policy shall prevent the District from denying the admission of a student during the term of his/her expulsion from another public school district in Wisconsin.
