ENERGY CONSERVATION

The Board shall encourage and support an energy conservation and education program in the District to substantially lower consumption of electricity, natural gas and water. It shall be the responsibility of each District employee and student to actively participate in conservation efforts in order to reduce consumption to levels prescribed by state and federal guidelines.

The District shall participate in energy conservation programs approved by the Board. Energy management is necessary in order for the District to minimize the impact energy cost increases will have on the budget, to maintain a reliable supply of energy to meet the functional needs of the District, and to ensure that energy is used efficiently.

A strong commitment, on the part of the Board and the Administration, is important to an effective energy management program.

The director of buildings and grounds shall implement, direct, monitor, evaluate and report District energy conservation efforts to the Board.
