

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

The Board shall provide transportation services to all school children living two or more miles from their school of attendance and to school children living in "areas of unusual hazard" (see Policy #751.4). In addition, the Board shall provide transportation for children with exceptional educational needs in accordance with state law and may provide transportation for out-of-district extracurricular activities.

Transportation services shall be under the direction of the transportation supervisor. The Board considers school buses to be an extension of the school facility.

Therefore, all rules and regulations concerning student conduct shall be enforced. Administrators have the authority to revoke transportation services for students who fail to observe such rules and regulations.

Daycare centers within two miles of the District may request transportation to and from school if they meet all of the requirements listed below:

1. The daycare center must be state-licensed and provide a copy of their license annually to the District.
2. In order for transportation to be provided to the daycare center, they must have approval from the Board.
3. The availability of transportation to and from daycare centers that are located within the two-mile distance from the school will be limited to the available number of seats on the routes available. If providing transportation to or from a daycare center required the District to add an additional route to their schedule, the daycare center would not qualify for transportation. Transportation would be eliminated according to longevity of service with the daycare that was most recently approved for transportation being the first to be eliminated.
