

TRANSPORTATION FOR PRIVATE SCHOOL PUPILS

The Board shall provide transportation to and from the school attended for each pupil residing in the District who attends any private elementary grade, including kindergarten, middle/junior high or high school if located 2 miles or more from the parent's/guardian's residence, if such private school is a school within whose attendance area the pupil resides and is situated within the District. The Board will also provide transportation if the private school is not more than 5 miles beyond the boundaries of the District measured along the usually traveled route.

The Board may provide transportation by contract with the parent or guardian of the pupil to be transported.

By May 15 of each year, each eligible private school shall notify the Board of the names, grade levels, and locations of all pupils, if any, eligible to have transportation provided by the District and planning to attend such private school during the forthcoming school year.

The Board will not be obligated to provide transportation of pupils to private schools if such notification is not received by May 15 unless required by other State Statutes.

The amount paid per child for a parent transportation contract will be calculated in accordance with state law.
