

NO TRESPASSING ON DISTRICT PROPERTY

District grounds are public property. As with most publicly owned property there are restrictions related to accessing the grounds. This policy outlines the terms and conditions related to access to District property.

During hours when school is in session, any person not in official attendance or on official school business shall not enter into, congregate, wander, stroll, or stand in any school building in the District. All visitors must sign in to the office and receive a visitor's ID.

In addition, there will be no trespassing on District property between the hours of 4:00 p.m. -7:00 a.m. on days when school is in session and at all times when school is not in session.

The areas covered under this policy include:

Parkview Elementary School (PES) from the north of N. Center St. and the chain link fence on the south side and east side of the faculty parking lot and bounded on the west side by the parking lot and on the north side by the large hill.

The PES playgrounds are accessible between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on days when school is in session and from 9:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. when school is not in session.

Parkview Junior/Senior High School (PJH/HS) from the north side of the sidewalk on Beloit St. on the south, bounded by the service drive and baseball field chain link fence on the east, the football field chain link fence and discuss field on the north and Maple Street on the east.

There will be no trespassing in or around the retention pond, arboretum and school pond. The football field/track, bleachers, discuss field, softball field and bleachers and small baseball/softball field and bleachers are accessible for legitimate school, community or exercise activities. School and community activities are defined as those activities carried out after approval of a District facility request. Examples include but are not limited to activities such as Viking Youth, June Days.
