Holiday Assistance Program

For the past several years, the Parkview School District has collaborated with other community resources to help assist families who are struggling financially during the holiday season. We have been able to supply our Parkview families with food, toiletries, clothing, and toys for their children. We are working together again this year, to offer this program. Notes have been sent home with each student that informs families that this program is being offered to those who are in need of financial support during this holiday season. If families were asking for support then they were asked to fill out a questionnaire detailing their children's needs and send the note back to school.

We have placed Giving Trees up at the schools and at the Orfordville Public Library with ornaments hanging on them. These ornaments have items written on them that are requested by families for the holidays. These requests may include toiletry items, clothing, or toys for their children. We are asking people to take an ornament or two and purchase these needed items and return them so we can gather the gifts and distribute them by the holiday. Please return the gifts
