REVISED-Parkview Enrollment Sees an Upswing of 61 students for 2018-19

The title of this article is not a typo. Just ask your children about all the new faces in the hallways and classrooms at Parkview. The new faces are the result of Parkview experiencing an increase of 61 new students in the hallways. This is the first time in over 15 years that enrollment has grown.

Parkview's third Friday count on September 21, which is the Department of Public Instruction's official student enrollment count day, verified Parkview's enrollment grew by 43 students for state revenue purposes (Residents students - open enroll in students = enrollment for revenue purposes). This increase included a reduction of 5 students that open enrolled out of Parkview (From 142 in 17-18 to 135 in 18-19) and an increase of 5 students that open-enrolled into Parkview from another district (From 62 in 17-18 to 67 in 18-19). As a result, the actual change in students in attendance at Parkview increased 61 as compared to 2017-18 (From 743 in 17-18 to 804 in 18-19).

The increase in enrollment is a welcome event for the teachers, staff, administration and Board of Education; all of which work very hard to help all students achieve to their greatest potential. To be assured,

more work is to be done to keep achievement going up but the nice bump in enrollment is evidence that the hard work is paying off and is being noticed.
