Kids Cross Country Style Fun Run

There are four runs divided by age/distance. Boys and girls will run together. Cross country team members will run with the youth to guide them on the routes. All distances are approximate and will be run on a cross country style course. The divisions and distances are:

9:00 a.m. - Kindergarten (and younger) – approximately ¼ mile

9:10 a.m. - 1st/2nd graders – approximately ½ mile

9:20 a.m. - 3rd/4th graders – approximately ¾ mile

9:30 a.m. - 5th/6th graders – approximately 1 mile
