Go Math: We currently use Go Math for our math curriculum. Now we are looking into using a math program called "Bridges" that will be more engaging (hands on) and less worksheets. If this is approved by the School Board, the school will need to purchase carts to store items of this program. The school is asking the PTO to help in the purchase of these carts. Then, if this is approved, Karen asked if volunteers would be willing to put these carts together. This part would happen before June 8th. Teri made a motion to purchase 16, 20 drawer carts, contingent on the Board approving this curriculum, up to the amount of \$1500.

We agreed to donate money to the Student Council for letting us use their popcorn supplies for the dance and Seuss week.
